Honda cadet drivers (P) next to their race numbers have previously finished in the top five of an A-Final and are recognised as “Pros”. Pro drivers are eligible to win trophies awarded to drivers placed 1st to 5th in the A-Final.

Honda cadet drivers (no P) also compete for Clubman trophies awarded to the first 5 non-Pro finishers in the A-Final.

Clubman drivers who finish in the top 5 overall will claim 2 trophies and be promoted to “Pro”; they will no longer be eligible to compete in the Clubman Class.

Trophies for other classes are awarded dependent on number of participants and position.

There was a little movement in the top five places. In R1, Charlie Gaillard (74) took 1st place in Heats 1 and 2 and the Final, but Heat 3 found him at unlucky 13th. He had better luck in R2 with three 1sts and a 2nd in Heat 1. Oliver Bowen (55) managed a 1st and two 2nds (including the Final) for R1. His luck tailed off in R2 starting with a 1st in Heat 1, then 2nd 4th and 5th in the Final. Oliver Gaillard (20), competing only in R1, came 3rd in the Final - his only other place was 4th in Heat 3. Luke Bate (95) was more consistent than most in with placings in every race in both rounds: R1: 2nd 3rd 4th and 5th; R2: 3rd, 4th, 5th, 2nd. Jake Cox (26) spent most of R1 in midfield but sneaked into 5th for the Final. Freya Woodall (16) only took part in R2, managing 3rd in the Final and Heat 3 with 5th places in the remaining races. Oliver Rands (27) took 4th in the Final and Heat 1 and a 2nd and a 3rd in the remaining races.

JUNIOR ROTAX

The top places were closely guarded in both rounds with the same drivers sharing the trophies. Jenson Weston (34) took 1st in the R1 Final and came away with six podium positions over the course of the weekend, including two more 1sts, a 2nd and a 3rd. Matthew Copsey (97) managed a total of eight podiums, winning the Final in R2, and ending up with four 1st and four 2nd places. Alfie Campbell (40) had a podium finish in the Finals of both rounds: 3rd in the R1 and 4th in R2. He also had a total of eight top five positions over the weekend, including two 2nds and three 3rds. Sam Cooper (44) had a total of six top five positions including a 4th R1 Final and a 3rd in the R2 Final. Bryn Evans (77) also had six top five positions, trying each of the places out for size.

There were a lot of drivers in the 177 class and the field was pretty open with variable results throughout the weekend – it was nice to see some old faces back on track. In Round 1, Daniel Fleckney (7) took 1st place in the Final and Heat 1, a 2nd in Heat 3 but only managed 7th in Heat 2. Jay Ford (99) claimed 2nd in the Final and two 3rds and a 5th in the heats. Robert Reeve (15) took 2nd in Heat 2, a 3rd in the Final and two 4th places in Round 1 the claimed two 1sts in Round 2 (including the Final), a 3rd and a
