2026 Class Rules and Regulations: CLUB270

C270.1 To enter the **Club270** class, you must be a minimum of **14 years old** with proven driving experience as approved by RLK.

All entrants will have had proven driving experience by Red Lodge karting and must reach the minimum weight requirement: 50kg.

How to book in.

Race entries will be open on the Alpha system from the Monday following a race meeting on the Saturday for **MEMBERS ONLY**. After two weeks, entries will be opened to the general public. If you're a member, RLK cannot guarantee you an entry after the entries are open to the general public.

On the day.

Drivers will need to check into reception **NO** later than 8:15 am, drivers briefing at 8:30.

Each Driver will pick their four kart numbers for the day at that point. There will be no kart changes during qualifying and, during races, a kart may only be changed if a lap-time differential of at least 1.5s is shown. This decision is at the discretion of the RLK race director.

If a kart breaks down during a race, it will be swapped over but the driver will not be reinstated to their original position.

Race Format.

Practice/Qualifying, three Heats and a Final.

Championship points are totalled as per the Club2000 Championship Points System (see [here](#)).

Penalties are applied as per the Club2000 Penalties & Class Rules Regulations except P5.0 to P5.1c (see [here](#)).

C270.2 Classes.

It is intended that RLK will run two different championships within one race:

Lightweight: 50kg-69.9kg

Heavyweight: 70kg+

The two classes will form one big grid and is not separated by a gap. Points scored will be per class. E.g. The leader of the Lightweight class will receive 36pts alongside the leader of the Heavyweight class receiving 36pts.

C270.3 Weights

Weights will be as per the scales on the day. All drivers found to be underweight will be disqualified from the heat/final. If any driver is found to be underweight for the second time in the meeting, they will be asked to report to the Clerk of the Course. They may be excluded from the meeting subject to the Clerk of the Course's decision and/or have their point deducted from their Championship score.

Drivers must weigh in wearing full race equipment at all times.

Seat Inserts and Weighted seat inserts are permitted. Weighted seat inserts must have secured weight and must be approved by an RLK scrutineer or Clerk. No loose weights are permitted.

IMPORTANT:

For Kart Safety & Driver safety, weighted seats must be inspected by the Clerk or the scrutineer. A maximum amount of weight will be permitted; Drivers will need to be able to remove and place their own seat insert

without external assistance. If moving your seat insert is considered to be a “two-person job” then the driver may not be able to participate.

C270.4 All Drivers must report to Scrutineering wearing all of their protective equipment, ensuring that the ankles are protected and the whole foot is covered for inspection. Non-motorsport footwear may be used at the Clerk of the Course/Scrutineer’s discretion.
