Honda cadet drivers (P) next to their race numbers have previously finished in the top five of an A-Final and are recognised as "Pros". Pro drivers are eligible to win trophies awarded to drivers placed 1st to 5th in the A-Final.

Honda cadet drivers (no P) also compete for Clubman trophies awarded to the first 5 non-Pro finishers in the A-Final.

Clubman drivers who finish in the top 5 overall will claim 2 trophies and be promoted to "Pro"; they will no longer be eligible to compete in the Clubman Class.

Trophies for other classes are awarded dependent on number of participants and position.

He also claimed five fastest laps over the season and a lap record. Only ten points behind him, second place Jenson Weston (34) also attended every round claiming four 1st places and managed the fastest lap in Round 1. Third place 3rd Matthew Copsey (97) claimed one 1st place trophy and three 2nds as well as two fastest laps. Most improved driver Elliot Reed-Hughes (95) drove himself into the top three positions in five out of the eight rounds he attended claiming a fastest lap in Round 5.
